GENERAL INFORMATION

1. HOTEL ACCOMMODATION

Registered participants already received an individual mail message with confirmation of their hotel accommodation and travel arrangements.

2. CONFERENCE FEE

The conference fee for participants is **350 Euro** and includes a copy of the proceedings and all social events. It can be reduced by 50% for those participants spending not more than two nights at the Hotel.

Payment by cash can be made in Euros as well as in US dollars or Swiss Francs; the exchange rate will be defined accordingly to the change established on Friday, February 26. Currencies different from the ones mentioned above will not be accepted.

In addition, payment of the conference fee can be made by Euro checks (EC), personal and traveler's checks. **Credit cards cannot be accepted.**

Prepayment of the conference fee can be made via bank transfer at the UBS (Union de Banque Suisse), CERN Branch, Account n. C7-108.024.0 (account name "Les Rencontres de Physique de La Vallée d'Aoste"). People paying in advance are kindly requested to bring a copy of the receipt to the registration desk.

3. TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS

Participants are expected to reach La Thuile by private car or by the conference buses, connecting Geneva (CERN and Airport) and Milano (Malpensa Airport, only) to the conference venue. There will be two buses from Milano Malpensa Airport and one bus from Geneva.

Participants traveling by car are reminded that in Aosta Valley it is mandatory to carry snow chains. Private cars can be parked in the Hotel garage, free of charge.

If the information about flights has not yet been provided, participants arriving by plane and willing to use the conference bus service are kindly requested to send an e-mail specifying the details about all legs of their travel (airline, flight number, expected arrival time).

Participants traveling by bus from CERN to La Thuile are informed that the bus will stop at Geneva Airport 30 minutes later (14.00). There is no public transportation connecting Geneva to La Thuile. People should keep this in mind while booking their flight to Geneva. We strongly encourage people traveling from overseas to carefully look at the schedule at Milano Malpensa airport which is a large hub with many direct flights to US and Asia.

The time schedule to and from Hotel Planibel, La Thuile is as follows:

Upon arrival Sunday, February 27

- 11:00 1st bus departure from Milano Malpensa
- 14:00 2nd bus departure **from Milano Malpensa**

The meeting point is in front of a café located between the two exits of the Terminal 1. In this area you will find a conference poster and you will meet somebody of the conference staff one hour before the bus departure (i.e. 11:00).

The bus ride to/from Milano Malpensa takes about 2h30'.

- 13.30 Bus departure from CERN to Geneva Airport
- 14.00 Bus departure from Geneva Airport to La Thuile

The meeting point at CERN is at the "Pio visitors car park" close to the COOP Cafeteria in the Main Building; the meeting point at Geneva airport is at the Arrivals gate.

The bus ride to/from Geneva takes about 2h30'.

- 14.30 Bus departure from Hotel Planibel to Geneva Airport and CERN
- 14.30 Bus departure from Hotel Planibel to Milano Malpensa

In addition there is a public **shuttle bus** (cost is 35 Euro) connecting Milano-Malpensa Airport with the Planibel Hotel in La Thuile (and back) operating on the weekends. The bus from La Thuile to Milano-Malpensa must be booked and paid (35 Euro) at the Hotel Planibel reception within the Wednesday before. More information will be available at the Conference Secretariat.

An overhead projector will be available as usual, however we will also have a projector that can be directly hooked up to a PC (provided by the Conference) for fully electronic presentations.
